Creating a doll like Emma was a childhood dream. I have always wanted a doll like she is: Soft, cuddly, likeable. Unique, that no one else has the same. The design was based on traditional porcelain dolls, so I had to go into a lot of side branches of design before I stopped experimenting with porcelain-like materials. Emma is made of natural materials: wood, fabric and natural filling. She has a classical style so she recalls the era when the games were personal and unique. Each doll is a different character, because they were made with handwork... made with care and love.
